

# Symposium on Aging

## Course Objectives

At the completion of this activity participants should be able to:

1. Identify best practices related to optimizing the health and functional status of geriatric primary care patients, including those with dementia. Desired Result: Identify Alzheimer's and related dementias among elderly patients.
2. Identify resources for caregivers of elderly patients. Desired Result: Recognize when to refer patients to specialized resources such as the Memory and Aging Center.
3. Recognize the best practices related to prescribing and managing medications that are common among geriatric primary care patients. Desired Result: Identify instances of opioid abuse in the elderly.
4. Identify, assess, and treat co-morbid psychiatric conditions common among primary care patients. Desired Result: Recognize the positive impact of an integrated interdisciplinary care team in addressing behavioral health issues.


